Foyos launches a modular work furniture system that bridges the gap between workshop and living space.

Lüneburg, 12 March 2026 – With a new way of thinking, Foyos introduces a new furniture category: a modular system of work furniture that dissolves the traditional boundary between living and working spaces. The collection combines the functional performance of classic workshop furniture with a clear, contemporary design language. The result is a new type of furniture for spaces where people work, create and live.

Sustainably designed and built to last.

Developed in collaboration with product designer Mark Braun, the system consists of worktables, wall elements and storage modules that reinterpret classic workshop archetypes and translate them into a modular structure. Solid oak, precise wood joinery and durable materials form the constructive foundation. Designed to be repairable and built for longevity, the pieces are produced with selected partners in Germany and across Europe.

Flexible. Never compromising.

The individual elements can be flexibly combined and adapted to different working styles, spaces and requirements. In this way, work environments emerge that can evolve over time and grow together with their users.

## Social media presence and 3daysofdesign.

With its launch in March 2026, Foyos becomes publicly visible for the first time. Alongside its own website and integrated online shop, the brand is establishing a presence across several social media platforms, creating a direct exchange with its community.

An initial international appearance will follow at **3daysofdesign in Copenhagen**, where the system can be experienced in a physical setting for the first time. In addition, Foyos plans collaborations with leading creatives from a wide range of disciplines in order to build international visibility and relevance.

“We never set out to develop just another piece of furniture,” says founder Paul Gummert. “Our goal was to create something that treats design ambition and functionality as equals.” With this approach, Foyos positions itself between workshop and living space and opens a new perspective on furniture for spaces of making.
